The mission of the Ashford Housing Authority is to provide affordable housing to elderly and handicapped individuals who are on fixed incomes.

Ashford Housing Authority manages the Pompey Hollow Senior Housing complex which offers 32 spacious one bedroom apartments quietly nestled in Warrenville near Pompey Hollow Park across Route 44 from Knowlton Memorial Hall.

The Ashford Housing Authority meets monthly in Pompey Hollow Housing every third Tuesday at 7:30 pm. The Annual Meeting is the third Tuesday in January.

All Pompey Hollow apartments are one bedroom with a full kitchen and lots of storage space. Other amenities include:

- Cable TV provided at a discount
- No Security deposits
- On-site laundry
- Indoor mailboxes
- Free Parking available
- Handicap accessible units available
- Cats allowed
- Located behind Ashford Senior Center
- Affordable rent based on 30% of adjusted monthly income
- Resident Service Coordinator available to help with services such as Medicare and other social programs.
- Income and age restrictions apply
- Equal housing opportunity

Interested persons who wish to obtain an application for housing or who wish to find out more information are encouraged to call or stop by the office. Volunteers are also welcomed to serve as a Commissioner on the Housing Authority itself.
